Forging the Frick Collections in Pittsburgh & New York

ABOUT THE EXHIBITION

This spring, The Frick Pittsburgh will host a once-in-generations exhibition bringing together the most complete viewing of the Frick family's art collection from both Pittsburgh and New York. **Vermeer, Monet, Rembrandt: Forging the Frick Collections in Pittsburgh & New York** will take place April 6 – July 14, 2024.

By presenting major works from The Frick Collection alongside related works from The Frick Pittsburgh, the exhibition will unite different facets of the collections and tell, for the first time, the compelling story of how Henry Clay Frick rose to become arguably America's greatest art collector, while revealing the hitherto unknown role of his daughter, Helen, in that enterprise.

An exhibition of this magnitude and caliber would be incomplete without a celebration. The Frick Fête will be a glittering Gilded-Age-style soiree under the stars on the stunning grounds of The Frick Pittsburgh on June 22, 2024. The sprawling event will activate the entire campus with drinks, art, and lively entertainment.

The Fête Dinner event will feature a cocktail hour and seated dinner. Following dinner, community ticketholders will join for a rousing after-party with drinks, decadent desserts, and dancing under the stars. Fête dinner tickets have very limited availability.
