WINDSOCKS

Windsocks are often used to tell how windy it is outside. They can also be used to celebrate something special.

The windsock you make will be a wonderful way to brighten up your home!





MATERIALS

- paper
- markers, crayons, or pencils (something to draw with)
- scissors
- glue
- string or ribbon
- tissue paper or streamers
- hole punch



Create a design. Add your design to your paper with it horizontal. You can use these pictures as a reference. Try to leave a little space on one side for when you shape the windsock.








Step 2

Once you have completed your design, add your streamers. If you don't have streamers you can add strips of tissue paper or even string. This detail will help your windsock dance in the wind.



Step 3

It's time to put it all together!
Once all the decorations you added have dried, add a strip of glue to the blank edge. Next roll the paper and bring the edges together. You may need some paper clips to hold it in place until it dries.



Step 4

The last step is to punch two holes on opposite sides of your windsock. Then you can add your string so you can hang it up.
