THE FRICK PITTSBURGH ANNOUNCES ELECTION OF ROBERT M. HERNANDEZ TO BOARD CHAIR

PITTSBURGH, PA, April 6, 2022 – The Frick Pittsburgh announces the election of Robert M. Hernandez to the position of Chairman of the Board of Trustees effective April 1. Mr. Hernandez succeeds former Board Chairman, David Burstin, who was elected to the position of Trustee Emeritus also effective April 1.

Mr. Hernandez was born and raised in Pittsburgh, Pennsylvania. He is a 1966 magna cum laude graduate of the University of Pittsburgh in Economics and Mathematics. In 1968, Mr. Hernandez received an M.B.A. degree in Finance from the Wharton School of Finance & Commerce, University of Pennsylvania, where he finished first in his class.

Mr. Hernandez joined United States Steel Corporation in 1968 and proceeded through a series of financial and operational positions as the company was transformed into a major energy corporation with the acquisitions of Marathon Oil Company and Texas Oil & Gas Corporation, along the way renaming itself USX Corporation. At various times, Mr. Hernandez was Treasurer, Comptroller, President & Chief Operating Officer of the Diversified Group, and Chief Financial Officer, concluding his career in 2001 as Vice Chairman and Chief Financial Officer.

Mr. Hernandez was Lead Director of Chubb Limited (formerly ACE Ltd.) and Lead Director of Eastman Chemical Company until his retirement from those boards in 2020. He was also Chairman of the Board of RTI International Metals, Inc. until its acquisition in 2015 by Alcoa, and was Chairman of the Board of the

BlackRock Open End Equity & Bond Mutual Funds until 2019. Mr. Hernandez also served as a director of TE Connectivity, Ltd. from 2007 until 2012.

Mr. Hernandez is a member of the University of Pittsburgh's Board of Trustees, serving since 2002 on numerous committees and for six years as Vice Chairperson of the Board. He also served on the Board of UPMC from 2001 until 2020, most of that time as Chairman of the Finance Committee.

Trustee Emeritus Mr. Burstin has served on the Frick Board as a Term Trustee since 2011, and as Chairman of the Board from May 2019 – March 2022. The founding partner of Brand Burstin & Runnette, an insurance firm that works in fringe benefits and estate and financial planning, Mr. Burstin has also served on the boards of Phipps Conservatory and Botanical Gardens, Pittsburgh Public Theater, and the United Way of Allegheny County, among many other community organizations. He holds a Bachelor of Science degree from Penn State, and a Masters in Financial Services from the American College of Financial Services.
